

Progress Update of Green Enclave Bharakahu:

Alhamdulillah, all outstanding issues with the land provider/developer i.e. M/S Green Tree (Pvt) Ltd. stand resolved with the active assistance of NAB. Accordingly, land for 3268 plots shall be provided by M/S Green Tree. The revised layout plan has been submitted to CDA for approval to be followed by signing of Construction Agreement between HF and M/S Green Tree. Therefore, remaining 1558 members who could not be issued consent letters shall be receiving the same alongwith brochure of the scheme. All 3268 allottees are requested to adhere to the payment schedule available in brochure, as scheme is expected to be formally launched very soon.

Progress Update of Green Enclave Bharakahu Extension:

In the wake of position taken by Ministry of Interior regarding cancellation of notification under Section 4 of Land Acquisition Act, the deadline for depositing down payment of land cost has been extended till 30th June. Moreover, open competitive bids on Least Cost Selection Method of procurement have been invited for 15000 kanals of compact land contiguous to original Green Enclave Bharakahu with minimum undulating topography. Upon receipt of bids, the same shall be shared with all prospective allottees who have deposited the land cost (refundable along with premium) for further action to be taken according to preferences of prospective allottees.

Progress Update of F-14/F-15

FGEHF is pleased to inform that the joint Award for Land/Built-up Property of Sector F-14/F-15 is ready to be announced by Land Acquisition Collector. Assessment of BUPs is complete through GIS based survey conducted by the Punjab Urban Unit. Data of all 76000 officers of Membership Drive Phase-II has been uploaded on the website of FGEHF with the request to prospective allottees to kindly verify their antecedents for correction if required. Preliminary planning of Sector F-14/F-15 is complete and infrastructure development works' contract has been awarded to M/S FWO through open competitive bidding following PPRA Rules. Accordingly, consent letters to approximately 6000 prospective allottees will be issued, preferably before Eid with the request to kindly deposit down payment for cost of land with FGEHF, for announcement of award.
